

WHAT is it?

8 weekly sessions of “Catholicism 201” (C201) will be presented Wednesday evenings, beginning June 6th. C201 continues where the ALPHA Course left off, but prior ALPHA participation is not required.

ALPHA presented elements of Christianity that are held in common by all Christians. C201 examines aspects of Christianity that generally speaking, are uniquely Catholic

(starting with the Church itself). This subset of C201 also explores the 7 Sacraments. The content is nearly identical to what adults are given who are preparing to enter the Catholic Church.

Each video talk, presented by Father James Mallon, is about an hour long. Discussion time after each talk will encourage questions and comments in small groups.

Schedule for the Evening

Each *Catholicism 201* evening consists of four parts:

1. A shared meal.
2. A time of community prayer.
3. An hour-long video presentation by Fr James Mallon of an aspect of the Catholic faith (See “The Talks” below).
4. Small group discussion.

WHY Should I Come?

Most of us are “informed” about what the Catholic Church says through our phones, the web or the secular media. Pope Francis’s many comments are routinely filtered, taken out-of-context, summarized, and distorted (either intentionally or not) to fit the message the media is trying to send.
