The Public Forum held on Tuesday evening was attended by 51 people. Following presentations, discussion and inputs from the floor, a resolution was proffered.

The Resolution adopted by an overwhelming majority, with no votes against and a small number of abstentions on specific points.

The Resolution will be displayed on our website shortly. *The Forum also decided that the PPC Task Team should hold future public meeting to discuss more specific suggestions and recommendations to combat sex abuse and the abuse of authority in the Church.*
